- PACSAE and WIOA partners together so that students working on their high school diploma also receive training and opportunities for internships. WIOA helps with resume writing, interview practice, and professional dress for interviews. Students who participate in WIOA tend to have more opportunities post graduation.
- WIOA coaches students with career development, job placement, and provides support with locating potential employers.
- Leadership development that includes the possibility of paid internships.
- The earning potential of a student participating in WIOA is greater than students that do not.
